Cruise-Inns begin at Little Falls Marina

LITTLE FALLS — The weekly Cruise-Inns at the Little Falls Marina are under way, according to Mike Bulger, who coordinates the events.

He discussed the schedule during the June 4 Common Council meeting.

Cruise-Inns run from 5 to 8 p.m. each Thursday from June through September at the marina. Each Cruise-Inn concludes with a parade of vehicles through the city.

Special events on the calendar include Valve Cover Racing on the first Thursday of each month, a performance by the Happy Haggs on June 20 and Christmas in July on July 11 with a prize for the car best decorated with a Christmas theme. There will be a Bug Country live radio remote on July 25. The latter will include a giveaway of Keith Urban tickets and transportation. The Aug. 29 Cruise-Inn will feature the Happy Haggs and a fireworks display.

Bulger described Valve Cover Racing as being a little like a Pinewood Derby. Competitors generally construct a vehicle using a valve cover from a car's engine, according to online sources, but Bulger said participants race all kinds of creations.

The charity that will benefit from the car shows is ICAN, formerly Kids Oneida.
